trans. from Careston in 1681; trans. to Arbroath after 3rd June 1686

1686 ALEXANDER GUTHRIE, M. A.

(Edinburgh 1682); pres. by William, Duke of Queensberry, and Robert, Earl of Southesk, 24th and 27th May, coll. 26th Oct., and inst. 7th Dec, 1686; dep. by Presb. of Dumfries 16th June 1691, "for profaning the sacrament of baptism", etc. – [G. R. Hornings, 7th July 1688; MS. Acc. of Min. 1689; Dumfries Presby. Reg.]

1696 ANDREW DARLING, M. A.

ord. before 13th Oct 1696; trans. to Kinnoull between 11th May and 26th Dec. 1697

1700 JAMES CURRIE, M. A.

(Edinburgh 13 July 1695); licen. by Presb. of Earlston 16th Sept. 1697; called by Presb. jure devoluto, and ord. 9th May; 1700; died 25th Feb. 1726, aged 52. He marr. Isobel Bell, who survived him and had issue – James, min. of Middlebie; John; Andrew; Helen (marr. Thomas Bell in Westside of Blacksyke); Agnes; James; Sybella – (Tombst)

1729 ALEXANDER ORR

born 1686, son of Alexander O., min. of St Quivox; licen. by Presb. of Ayr 22nd June 1715; ord. to Muirkirk 5th June 1717; called 26 Feb., trans. and adm. 10th July, 1729; died 19th June 1767. He marr. 25 Jan 1722, Agnes (died 21st May 1760), daugh. of John Dalrymple of Waterside, and had issue – Agnes, born 9th Nov. 1722 (marr. William Young, min. of Hutton); Barbara, born 10th Oct.. 1723 (marr. John Craig, min. of Ruthwell); Alexander, W. S. born 23 March 1725, died 27th Nov. 1774; Peter, born 12th Oct. 1727; John, merchant, Virginia; Susan (marr. 1768, William Murray, sec-ond son of William M. of Murraythwaite) (Tombst.; M'Call's Some Old Families.)

1768 ALEXANDER BROWN

trans. from Tongland, and adm. 26th July 1768; trans. to Moffat 30th Oct 1783. 1784 JAMES YORSTOUN, born 17 Dec. 1755, son of Peter Y., min. of Closeburn; licen. by Presb. of Penpont 5th July 1775; ord. to Middlebie 23rd March 1778; pres. by William, Duke of Queensberry 8th Jan., and adm. 1st July 1784; died 6th April 1834. He marr., 2nd Oct. 1817, Margaret (died 25th March 1828), daugh. of James Currie Carlyle of Brydekirk. Publication – Account of the Parish (Sinclair's Stat. Acc. iii, xxi).

1834 ROBERT MENZIES

born 31st Jan 1801, son of William M., min. of Lanark; educated at the Grammar School there, High School, Edinburgh (dux 1816), and Univ. of Edinburgh; licen. by Presb. of Lanark, 4th August 1824; pres. by Lieut- General Matthew Sharpe of Hoddam, and ord. 2nd Sept. 1834; D. D. (Edinburgh, April 1864); died 6th July 1877. He marr. 28th Oct. 1835, Martha Reid (died 19 July 1875), daugh. of Robert Coldstream, merchant, Leith, and Elizabeth, daugh. of John Phillips, and had issue – William, min. of Duns; Robert Coldstream, born 11th July 1839, died 1st Sept. 1870; Allan, born 23 June 1841, died 29th Nov. 1892; John Coldstream, lieut., R. E., born 8th April 1843, died 2nd May 1866; Elizabeth Phillips, born 23rd June 1844, died 29 July 1865; Jeanie Newbigging, born 23rd Sept. 1845, died at Hyeres, France, 8th March 1892; Martha Reid Coldstream, born 12th April 1847, died 18th May 1914; Lawrie, engineer, born 16 June 1848, died at Alexandrowsk, South Russia, 11th Dec. 1914; Francis, born 22nd June, died 16th Dec. 1849; Alexander Charles, born 23 Aug. 1850, died 24th March 1875; Catherine Cowan, born 12th Oct. 1852, died 18th Oct. 1879.
